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The July Board Meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority (RVBA) was held on Friday July 16, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. at the RVBA's office located at 601. S. Jefferson Street, Suite 110, Roanoke, VA.

1. CALL TO ORDER, WELCOME AND ROLL CALL

Chairman McEvoy called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and welcomed those in attendance. Tywanii Ross, Assistant Secretary to the Broadband Authority, called the roll and Chairman McEvoy reported that a quorum was present. Frank Smith introduced Matthew Shaughnessy, Account Executive, with Wallace 360, who is working on Branding and Marketing. Chairman McEvoy announced another addition to the Agenda taking Wayne Strickland former Secretary from the Bank Signature cards and adding Matt Miller, Secretary. Chairman McEvoy moved acceptance that Matt Miller be added to the bank signature cards, and to delete Wayne Strickland. Vice Chairman Dan O' Donnell, Roanoke County, moved approval of the motion. The motion was seconded by Bob Cowell, City of Roanoke. The motion was adopted by a vote of 5-1.

2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

The May 21, 2021 Minute of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Meeting were.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Mr. O'Donnell moved approval of the Minutes of the May 21, 2021 meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority, as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cowell, City of Roanoke and carried. Mr. McEvoy mentioned the endorsing of all minutes from remote meetings, Mr. McEvoy requested a motion to ratify the minutes from remote meetings. Dr. Scott Midkiff, Virginia Tech approved the motion for remote meetings. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cowell, City of Roanoke, and carried. Mr. Sam Darby mentioned when the City Council adopted its ordinance, in March of 2021, if for any reason the remote meetings were not effective when we get back to regular scheduled meetings, we would go ahead and approve them. No concerns were made that the remote meetings were not effective.

3. Treasurer's Report

Mr. Smith gave an overview of the financial statements for May 31, 2021 and year end June 2021. Mr. Smith mentioned that we surpassed our goals. Mr. Smith expressed thanks to the RVBA team, mentioning Jim Bandy with Operations, along with Tywanii Ross and Olivia Dooley and Barry Stacy, in addition to RVBA's partners. Mr. Smith stated the RVBA was on the right path for the new fiscal year which started July 1, 2021.

Mr. McEvoy requested a motion to accept the approval of the financials from May 2021 & June 2021. Mr. O'Donnell made the motion to accept the reports. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cowell, City of Roanoke, and carried.

4. RVBA Project Update

Mr. Smith gave a project update on a joint meeting coming up on July 21, 2021 to support the localities for cross collaboration for Virginia Telecommunication Incentive Grants. The RVBA was working on press releases to support the event. Mr. Smith was interviewed by channel 7 WDBJ on July 15, 2021. The RVBA is continuing to expand its foot print with key enterprise customers which have not been publicly announced. In addition, the RVBA has created maps to reference where the network is and its plans to expand across the localities in Roanoke Count and Botetourt County. Mr. Frank Smith stated that there are also other projects in the works. Mr. Smith stated that Mrs. Ross joined the RVBA in March 2021 and has already been a great asset to the team. RVBA projects are on schedule and within budget. Mr. McEvoy asked if everyone was aware of the session coming up on the

VATI grants. Mr. Jay Taliaferro joined the meeting @ 8:39 a.m. In the special session on August 2, 2021, Mr. Frank Smith stated that of the \$4.3 billion, there is a question of how much will be available for Broadband. The Governor and Senator Warner have their announcement today @ 1:00 p.m. in Abingdon. Mr. Frank Smith stated that there are rumors of the amount of money to be allocated. The VATI grants are geared towards rural Broadband, and Mr. Smith mentioned the FCC standards of 25 Mbps down, and 3 Mbps up. Four Senators, including WV Senator Joe Manchin who are trying to get this changed to 100 over 100 Mbps. If a household is below the rate of 25 Mbps down and 3 Mbps up, the household is considered underserved or nonserved. These issues will be coming up in the special session. Mr.McEvoy asked if everyone was aware that RVBA has changed their Public Relations company. Mr. Mr. Smith stated that discussions have been had with all Board Members concerning this matter. Mr. Mike McEvoy wanted to know if the Auditors have started the audit yet. Olivia Dooley, Finance Director stated that the Auditors will be coming the last week of August 2021.

OTHER BUSINESS

The next Scheduled RVBA Board meeting will be September 17, 2021.

5. REQUEST FOR CLOSED SESSION

Chairman McEvoy requested a motion to convene a closed session. Vice Chairman O'Donnell made the motion for a closed session, for the purpose of discussing the award of public contract involving the expenditure of public funds, including discussion of the terms or scope of such contract, where discussion in an open session would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the Authority, pursuant to 2.2-3711.A.29 and 3711.A.33 of the code of Virginia. The motion was seconded by Jay Taliaferro, City of Salem. Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority entered into a closed session @ 8:45 a.m. all Board members present with Frank Smith, except for Gary Larrowe, Botetourt County, who was absent.

END CLOSED MEETING AND RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING

Motion was made by Mr. Keith Perry to return from closed session to return to regular meeting and seconded by Mr. Cowell. Motion was adopted and carried by all except absent board member Mr. Gary Larrowe.
