

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY  
TO THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE, ROANOKE COUNTY, THE CITY OF SALEM, BOTETOURT  
COUNTY, AND OTHER INTERESTED ENTITIES**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 15.2-5431.25 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, that the Members of the Board of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority (the "Authority") will hold a public hearing on Friday, February 17, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. local time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Board Room on the Second Floor Offices of the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission, 313 Luck Avenue, S.W. Roanoke, VA 24016, to give those addressed above and all other interested persons an opportunity to be heard concerning the Authority's proposed rates, fees and charges. After the public hearing, the Board will be requested to adopt the preliminary proposed schedule of rates, fees and charges, either as originally approved by the Board and set forth herein or as may be amended by the Board after the public hearing, and to fix a date for such rates, fees and charges to take effect. Such public hearing may be adjourned from time to time without need for any further public notice.

**Notes:**

- 1) A five dollar Maintenance Fee per Dark Fiber strand mile per month will be charged
- 2) Non-profit is defined as localities, political subdivisions, school divisions, and state educational institutions
- 3) Non Recurring Charge (NRC) is a minimum of \$500 for all Transport and IP Service Offerings
- 4) NRC Charges may be amortized over the duration of a Master Services Agreement subject to Authority Approval
- 5) Service Lateral and Drop pricing will be determined on an Individual Case Basis (ICB)
- 6) Some pricing of Dark Fiber leases and irrevocable rights of use (IRU) will be negotiated with the Authority receiving in-kind services such as location of its facilities on lessee's premises
- 7) ICB's are services that will be designed, engineered, and priced on an Individual Case Basis (ICB) with a customer and are subject to Authority Approval
- 8) Dark Fiber for Commercial Carrier use is subject to Authority Approval and will be considered service of last resort after Network Capacity for Circuit Provisioning and Wavelength Provisioning is exhausted per the determination of the Authority
- 9) Wavelength service is available per Authority Approval as an ICB offering
- 10) Additional contract lengths may be negotiated as an ICB with Authority Approval
- 11) The Authority may offer Special Promotional Pricing from time to time that will only apply to new customer contracts

If the City of Roanoke Municipal Building Offices are closed because of weather or any other reasons on Friday, February 17, 2017, then the public hearing will be held on the following Friday, February 24, 2017, at 8:00 a.m. at the same place set forth above. All interested persons and entities are invited to attend the above public hearing and be heard on the above matters.
