Separate sealed Bids for the Spring Hollow Extension project for the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority (RVBA) which consists of the construction of approximately 2.5 miles of buried & 750 feet of aerial Corning MiniXtend 144 count fiber optic cable and 4-Way Future Path conduit with all appurtenances and installation of approximately 14 handholes, will be received by Olivia Dooley, Chief Financial Officer of RVBA, in the RVBA office located at 601 South Jefferson Street, Suite 110, Roanoke, VA 24011, until 2:00 P.M., local prevailing time, on January 15, 2019, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on December 19, 2018 at 11:00 A.M. All interested parties are requested to meet the Owner and Engineer at the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority office located at 601 South Jefferson Street, Suite 110, Roanoke, VA at that time. Questions must be submitted in writing using the Pre-Bid Question Form contained in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS no later than 4:00 P.M. on January 7, 2019. Responses, if any, will be issued via addendum, no later than January 9, 2019.

Withdrawal of bids shall be according to procedure (i) of the Virginia Public Procurement Act and to the Code of Virginia (§ 2.2-4330). Bids must be accompanied by Bid security as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

Each Bidder must be licensed as a Class A contractor in the State of Virginia; Bidders are instructed to review the *Code of Virginia*, Title 54.1, Chapter 11, prior to bidding.

MBE/WBE firms are encouraged to submit Bids. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any and all Bids if it appears in its best interest to do so.

The Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, religion, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment.
