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MINUTES

The July meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority was held on Friday, July 15, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. at the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission office, 313 Luck Avenue, SW, Roanoke, VA.

1. CALL TO ORDER, WELCOME AND ROLL CALL

Chairman Boggess called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and welcomed those in attendance.

Wayne Strickland, Secretary to the Broadband Authority, called the roll and reported that a quorum was present.

Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Members: *Present:* Kevin Boggess, City of Salem; Tom Gates, Roanoke County; Gary Larrowe, Botetourt County; Mike McEvoy, Citizen and Chris Morrill, City of Roanoke.

2. APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 10, 2016 MINUTES

The Minutes of the June 10, 2016 meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority were distributed earlier.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Upon motion by Vice Chairman McEvoy, seconded by Mr. Morrill and carried, the Minutes of the June 10, 2016 meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority were approved, as distributed.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT

The Financial Report, ending June 30, 2016, was provided earlier in the agenda mailing. Frank Smith noted that the Broadband Authority's finances are currently on track and under budget. Chairman Boggess stated that the Financial Report, ending June 30, 2016, would be filed, as presented.

4. PROJECT UPDATES

Frank Smith reported on the following project updates:

- Close to sign off on final completion of Phase I. Currently completing cement restoration in Roanoke City, and various landscaping, patching and paving as required by municipalities.
- Carrier grade network is now up and running and being monitored 24/7.
- Phase II work in Roanoke County is now underway. The network routes are being reviewed with internal stakeholders in Roanoke County. Most of the fiber will be underground but there will be limited aerial usage.

Jennifer Eddy, Eddy Communications, reported her PR firm is continuing to circulate news and successes of the Broadband Authority. She noted that articles on the Broadband Authority have been cited as far as Boston. A story on the Broadband Authority will appear in the August issue of the Virginia Municipal League (VML) quarterly publication. Additionally, an application for VML's "Innovation Award" has been submitted for review and consideration by Eddy Communications. Eddy Communications continues to work on a new website which will be user friendly (customer and citizen portals) to match the Broadband Authority's new branding efforts.

5. BRIEFING FROM MANAGEMENT STACK, LLC

Jennifer Eversole, CPA, Co-Founder, Partner-CFO of Management Stack, LLC addressed the Board about the advisory services of her agency. Management Stack helps to uncover problems and preempts adversity to make sure that the management team within a business understands how to handle risks. Ms. Eversole stated that businesses are now hiring CROs (Chief Risk Officers). They also offer consulting services to help businesses find solutions to specific challenges, as well as provide assurance services, which help businesses design organizational strategies that will assist in mitigating risk by strengthening their control environment.

6. REQUEST FOR CLOSED MEETING PURSUANT TO VIRGINIA CODE §2.2-3711

Motion was made by Vice Chairman McEvoy and seconded by Mr. Morrill to convene a closed meeting for the purpose of considering modifications to certain existing contracts as they apply to the extensions of these contracts (pursuant to Section 2.2-3711 A.29. of the Code of Virginia, 1950, As Amended, for discussion of the award of a public contract involving the expenditure of public funds, including interview of bidders or offerors, and a discussion of the terms and scope of such contract, where discussion in open session would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body [Authority]). The motion was adopted and carried by a vote of 5 to 0. The Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority went into a closed meeting at 8:58 a.m.

7. END CLOSED MEETING AND RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING

9. ACTION BY THE BOARD AS A RESULT OF THE CLOSED MEETING

Consideration of a Resolution Approving Contracts with (a) Thompson and Litton for Design and Contract Management Services, (b) Eddy Communications for Marketing, Communication and Branding Services, and (c) Walker and Associates, Inc. for Network Electronics, Software and Professional Services

Background: On June 10, 2016, the Authority Board adopted a resolution approving (in the event the President and CEO (Frank Smith) determined that such would be in the best interest of the Authority), the modification of or change orders to the contracts to provide for the continuation of the design, contract management, marketing, communication and branding services and network electronics, software and professional services for the Phase II - Roanoke County Extension. Mr. Smith determined and recommended to the Board that it would be in the best interest of the Authority to modify or enter into change orders to the contracts to provide for the continuation of the design, contract management, marketing, communication and branding services and network electronics, software and professional services for the Phase II - Roanoke County Extension. The Board authorized Mr. Smith to negotiate the modification of or change orders to the Contracts and required that he present them to the Board for approval in such form as he may recommend, such modification or change orders to be approved by formal action of the Board before they are executed and delivered by Mr. Smith.

At the July 15, 2016 Board meeting, Frank Smith presented the following modification of or change orders to the Contracts --

- (A) The contract price for the modification of or change order to the contract with Thompson and Litton would not exceed \$300,000.
- (B) The contract price for the modification of or change order to the contract with Eddy Communications would not exceed \$100,000.
- (C) The contract price for the modification of or change order to the contract with Walker and Associates would not exceed \$1,200,000, with \$600,000 being applied or allocated to electrical and related equipment components to be installed in the Phase II Roanoke County Extension and an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for software telecommunication construction materials.

Board members authorized and directed Frank Smith to negotiate, execute and deliver the modifications or change orders to the Contracts, as presented at the meeting; and to take all such further action as may be necessary or desirable in connection with and that are in conformity with the purposes and intent of the resolution.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Upon motion by Vice Chairman McEvoy, seconded by Mr. Larrowe and carried, the resolution approving the contracts for design/engineering and contract maintenance services; marketing, branding and communication services; and network electronics, software and professional services, per the modification of or change orders as presented by Mr. Smith,

was adopted, subject to review by legal counsel to ensure that all public procurement rules have been adhered to in support of the RVBA's commitment to excellence in all areas. Mr. Darby will inform Mr. Smith if there was any additional review required in the matter before executing the vendor agreements.

Motion was made by Vice Chairman McEvoy and seconded by Mr. Morrill to convene a closed meeting on the subject of the Broadband Authority's President & CEO's annual review and employment contract (pursuant to Section 2.2-3711 A.1. of the Code of Virginia, 1950, As Amended, to discuss personnel matters). The motion was adopted and carried by a vote of 5 to 0. The Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority went into a closed meeting at 9:24 a.m.

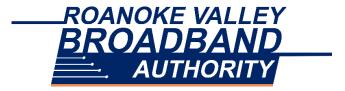
