

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MINUTES

The September Board Meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority was held on Friday, September 15, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority office located at 601 S. Jefferson Street, Suite 110, Roanoke, VA.

1. CALL TO ORDER, WELCOME AND ROLL CALL

Chairman Boggess called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and welcomed those in attendance. Wayne, Strickland, Secretary to the Broadband Authority, called the roll and reported that a quorum was present.

<u>Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Members</u>: <u>Present:</u> Kevin Boggess, City of Salem; Tom Gates, Roanoke County; Gary Larrowe, Botetourt County; Mike McEvoy, Citizen; and Sherman Stovall, City of Roanoke.

2. APPROVAL OF THE JULY 21, 2017 MINUTES

The July 21, 2017 Minutes of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Meeting were distributed earlier.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Vice Chairman McEvoy moved that the Minutes of the July 21, 2017 meeting of Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority be approved, as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Larrowe and carried.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT

A. Acceptance of the Financial Reports

The Financial Reports, ending July 31, 2017 and August 31, 2017, were distributed earlier in the agenda packet.

B. FY 2018 Budget Revision

Frank Smith reported to accommodate specific costs incurred this year, a reallocation of funds based on expense trends was made to the budget. No additional money is being requested. New line items were identified in the operating budget summary in the agenda packet. Chairman Boggess stated these line items are not increasing the budget, but rearranging the money within the budget for specific costs expected over the next year. It was noted that most of the new line items will be recurring costs that will be identified in future budgets. Concerning the billing system line item (\$21,500), Mr. Smith stated that the Authority contracted with a billing system for inventory control and billing. As the Authority builds its network and works with its other partners, it is essential to have an operational support system to build, track and deliver services (i.e., a foundational element for the network). The ARIN line item is the American Registry for Internet Numbers. Mr. Smith noted that the Broadband Authority is an authorized provider of Internet services. Mr. Smith also reported that \$4,000 a month is being placed into reserves to address depreciation expenses.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Vice Chairman McEvoy moved acceptance of the Financial Reports, ending July 31, 2017 and August 31, 2017, as presented, and approval of the proposed revisions to the FY 2018 Operating Budget, as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Stovall and carried.

4. PROJECT UPDATE

- The Broadband Authority is in partnership with ABS Technology as the first Internet service
 provider riding on the Authority's open access network to provide services to the Boxley
 Building.
- Mr. Smith will be speaking at two upcoming broadband national conferences.
- Construction for Phase II of the Roanoke County extension achieved substantial completion on August 21. September 21 is the final completion date and USC will have 30 days to finish the punch list and complete final testing of the network.
- Staff anticipates presenting a draft HR Manual and Strategic Plan for discussion by the Board at their next meeting.
- Mr. Smith reported that a Phase II lighting ceremony is scheduled for October 18 at the South County Library on Merriman Road.

5. OTHER BUSINESS

 Board members discussed the October and November meeting schedule of the Broadband Authority. Members agreed to cancel the October meeting, and that Friday, November 17, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. would be the next meeting date and time.

ROANOKE VALLEY BROADBAND AUTHORITY ACTION:

Mr. Gates moved that the October 20, 2017 meeting of the Broadband Authority Board be cancelled. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman McEvoy and carried.

- Sherman Stovall, Roanoke City board member, announced that he would be resigning his seat on the Broadband Authority. Mr. Stovall stated that Bob Cowell, Roanoke's new City Manager, would be appointed soon by City Council to serve as the City's board member on the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority. Chairman Boggess thanked Mr. Stovall for his input during his time on the Board and for his help throughout the transition phase after Chris Morrill's departure.
- Chairman Boggess reminded those in attendance of the Broadband Authority's open house and office ribbon cutting to follow at 10 a.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:20 a.m.

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
STAFF REPORT

SUBJ: Reappointment of Mike McEvoy as the Citizen-At-Large Representative on the Broadband Authority Board

Mike McEvoy's term as the Citizen-At-Large representative on the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board expires on December 13, 2017.

According to Article II of the Broadband Authority's Articles of Incorporation.... "The 4-members of the Board of the Authority shall recommend to the participating political subdivisions the appointment of the fifth member who shall be a citizen and resident of one of the participating political jurisdictions. The governing bodies of each participating political subdivision shall ratify and confirm the appointment of the fifth member."

Action Requested: Board members recommend to the participating political subdivisions the reappointment of Mike McEvoy to serve as the Citizen-At-Large representative (5th member) on the Board of the Broadband Authority for a four-year term ending December 13, 2021, and that each participating political subdivision ratify and confirm the reappointment of Mike McEvoy as the Citizen-At-Large representative.



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CERTIFICATION RESOLUTION
