MINUTES

The July Board Meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority was held on Friday, July 19, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. at the Broadband office located at 601 S. Jefferson Street, Suite 110, Roanoke, VA.

1. CALL TO ORDER, WELCOME AND ROLL CALL

Chairman McEvoy called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and welcomed those in attendance. Matt Miller, Assistant Secretary to the Broadband Authority, called the roll and reported that a quorum was present.

<u>Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Members</u>: Present: Gary Larrowe, Botetourt County; Mike McEvoy, Citizen; Dan O'Donnell, Roanoke County; and Jay Taliaferro, City of Salem. *Absent:* Bob Cowell, City of Roanoke.

2. <u>APPROVAL OF THE MAY 17, 2019 MINUTES</u>

The May 17, 2019 Minutes of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board Meeting were distributed earlier.

Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Action:

Jay Taliaferro moved approval of the Minutes of the May 17, 2019 meeting of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority, as presented. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman O'Donnell and carried.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT

• Acceptance of the Financial Reports

The Financial Reports, ending May 31, 2019 and June 30, 2019, were distributed earlier in the agenda packet.

Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Action:

Gary Larrowe moved that the Financial Reports, ending May 31, 2019 and June 30, 2019, be accepted, as presented. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman O'Donnell and carried.

<u>Ratification of Update to "Resolution and Agreement for Deposit Account" at BB&T</u> <u>Bank to Include Newly Elected Broadband Officers</u>

This item involved updating the BB&T account with who can sign checks on behalf of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority. The account at BB&T needs to be updated to add Dan O'Donnell (newly elected Vice Chair) to the list and to delete Kevin Boggess (former Chair) from the list. With the addition of Mr. O'Donnell, the other individuals authorized to sign checks include Mike McEvoy (Chair), Frank Smith (President & CEO), and Wayne Strickland (Secretary).

Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Action:

Gary Larrowe moved the ratification of update to the Resolution and Agreement for Deposit Account at BB&T Bank to include the addition of Dan O'Donnell's name to the list that is eligible to sign checks on behalf of the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority, and to delete Kevin Boggess' name (former Chair) from the list. The motion was seconded by Jay Taliaferro and carried.

4. **PROJECT UPDATES**

- Radford University is now a customer of the RVBA with service being turned-up in the Innovation District.
- The RVBA's network has not experienced a service interruption for more than two years.
- More service delivery points are being added to the RVBA network, including an extension of the network from Roanoke County's Center for Research and Technology (CRT) to service the Western Virginia Regional Jail and the Spring Hollow Reservoir Facility.
- Work continues on the development of the co-location facility at the Greenfield Industrial Park.
- Chairman McEvoy and Frank Smith executed an engagement letter with Robinson, Farmer, Cox Associates to perform auditing services for the Broadband Authority for the accounting period that covers July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019. The fee to conduct the audit will be \$8,100, and it will begin during August of 2019.

5. <u>REQUEST FOR CLOSED MEETING</u>

Motion was made by Vice Chairman O'Donnell and seconded by Gary Larrowe that the Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority Board convene a closed meeting to discuss: (1) strategic business development initiatives, pursuant to §2.2-3711.A.33 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, concerning discussion or consideration by a local authority created in accordance with the Virginia Wireless Service Authorities Act (§15.2-5431.1 et seq.) of confidential proprietary information and trade secrets subject to the exclusion in subdivision 19 of §2.2-3705.6; and (2) a personnel matter concerning the compensation and performance evaluation

of the Broadband President & CEO, pursuant to §2.2-3711.A.1 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.

The motion was adopted and carried by a vote of 4 to 0. The Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority entered into a closed meeting at 8:49 a.m.

6. END CLOSED MEETING AND RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING

Motion was made by Vice Chairman O'Donnell and seconded by Jay Taliaferro that the Broadband Authority end the closed meeting and return to its regular meeting. The motion was adopted and carried by a vote of 4 to 0. The Roanoke Valley Broadband Authority ended the closed meeting and returned to its regular meeting at 9:16 a.m.
